

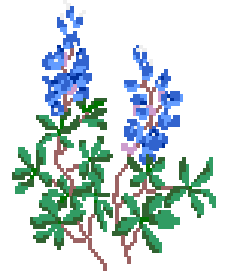

Saturday only: \$20. Sunday only: \$20

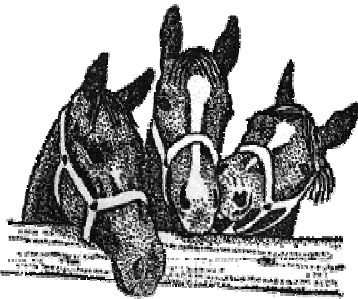
